Recipe Corner:

Mini Meatloaf muffins

16oz ground beef

1Cup Parmesan Cheese grated

1/3 Cup diced onions

1 egg

1/4 Cup Ketchup

5 pieces of bacon fried & crumbled

Salt & pepper to taste
