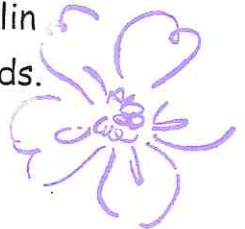
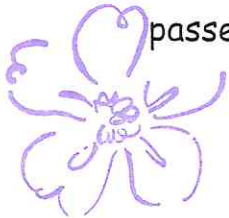
The Eichenberger Family, at the loss of Carl. Carl was a long time member of Power Of the Past. We will miss him and all that he did for our club.
